### FHLB—Affordable Housing Program

2013 special project of RAMPS

SCIL's RAMPS program secured grant funding to provide 30 home modifications in 2013. Projects incorporate various modifications with contract labor totaling a max of \$5,000 per project.

### Eligibility requirements:

- Homeowner living in Christian, Dallas, Greene, Lawrence, Polk, Stone, Taney or Webster counties
- Ability to sign a 5 year deed restriction agreeing not to sell your home, with a payback scale
- Person with a progressive or permanent physical disability and who cannot easily or safely live in their home without accommodations and modifications
- Household income must fall below the HUD guidelines for 80% or Low Income Limit by county resident

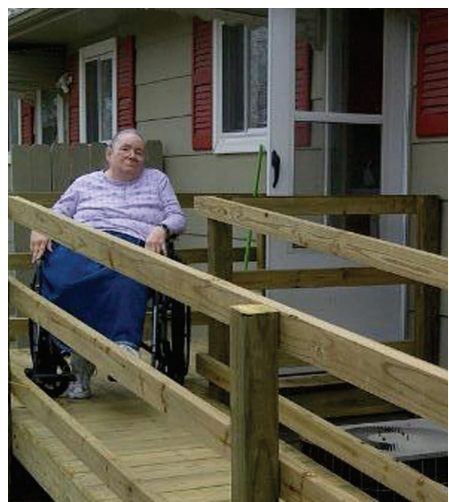
